## Linda Joette (Smith) Cope

Linda Joette Cope (1950 – 2019), joined Rolling Thunder in 2006 participating actively until her death. Linda served as the Chapter Secretary from September 2015 until June 2019.

Linda's brother Ronald E. Smith served in Vietnam becoming among the missing and unaccounted for on November 28, 1970 while on a mission near the tri-border area of Vietnam, Laos and Cambodia. Linda has been passionate and dedicated her entire life to finding out the details surrounding the mission, and the whereabouts of her beloved brother. Linda has carried on the mission of Rolling Thunder faithfully in educating the public on the POW-MIA issue. She authored the book **Still Waiting**, which chronicles her life growing up with her brother, and the years of agony in search for answers following her brother's missing-in-action declaration by the Department of Defense.

Linda has made several trips to Washington DC to visit her brother Ron who's name is listed on the Vietnam Memorial Wall. She has conducted several Missing Man Table ceremonies since she has joined the Chapter, and was a member that was truly dedicated to our POW/MIA mission. She will be missed but not forgotten. Please keep Linda's family in your prayers as they go through these difficult times.

Linda will finally be with Ron in heaven and will have the closure that she has been longing for.



## 2019 Chapter Elections

- In accordance to the National Constitution, all members will be duly notified of elections by an announcement at the June, July and August meeting.
- Only Rolling Thunder® members in good standing are eligible to vote.
- To be a member in good standing, you must have attended (3) Chapter meetings and (3) Chapter events with the membership year.
- Nominations will be taken at our July and August Chapter meetings only with the elections being held at our September 15th Chapter Meeting.
- The member being nominated must have attended six (6) Chapter meetings in the last twelve (12) months.
- **Therefore, the nominee attendance requirement will be six (6) Chapter meetings and three (3) events within the membership year.**
- The membership year is from September 1st, 2018 to August 31st 2019.
- In accordance with Indiana Chapter #1, Chapter Rules, dated 2 January 2014, "Anyone wishing to run for the office of President, Vice President, or Chairman of the Board, must first have held another office, i.e.: Treasure, Secretary, or Board member, for a full term, with Indiana Chapter #1.
- Any qualified patch wearing (Rocker/Eagle) Chapter Member in good standing may run for the Secretary, Treasurer, or Board Member position.
- The election committee for the 2019 Chapter election will be announced at the July Chapter meeting.
- The election committee will be responsible for taking the nominations for officers, hand out, collect, and count the ballots after the election in September.



# **Chapter President**

## **Duties and Responsibilities Description**

The Chapter President is an elected official with a (2) year term and is the Chief Executive Officer in charge of the daily operation of the Chapter. The Chapter President enhances the organization's public standing by clearly articulating the Rolling Thunder® mission statement, accomplishments, and goals to the public and garners support from the community.

**The duties of the Chapter President will include, but not limited to the following duties.**

- Responsible for the overall day-to-day operation, safety, management and financial order of the organization.
- The Chapter President ensures that all officers, board members and members follow the Constitution.
- The Chapter President sets the agenda and runs the monthly membership meetings and ensures all meetings are run according to the Constitution and Roberts Rules when applicable.
- The Chapter President gives agenda ideas for discussion to the Chairman of the Board for the Board Meetings. (The Chairman of the Board runs the Board Meeting).
- Serves as a member on the Rolling Thunder® Indiana Veterans Fund (RTIVF) Committee.
- Must have held another office, i.e.: Treasure, Secretary, or Board member, for a full term with Indiana Chapter #1.
- Must not miss (3) consecutive meetings without legitimate excuse.
- The President is responsible to the Vice President of Rolling Thunder® Inc. National. In some cases, through the State Liaison, if in the chain of command.

# **Chapter Secretary**

## **Duties and Responsibilities Description**

The Chapter Secretary is an elected official with a (2) year term. The Chapter Secretary attends and records the minutes of all meetings and is the records officer for the Chapter. The Chapter Secretary enhances the organization's public standing by clearly articulating the Rolling Thunder mission statement, accomplishments, and goals to the public and garners support from the community.

**The duties of the Chapter Secretary will include, but not limited to the following duties.**

- Recording, editing and maintaining all meeting minutes
- Maintains custody of all records, reports on behalf of the executive officers.
- Prepares and distributes all incoming/outgoing correspondences, memorandums etc.
- Assist in the preparation of the Organizational Activities Reports.
- Provides monthly minutes to the Chapter for review.
- Must not miss (3) consecutive meetings without legitimate excuse submitted to the Chapter President.
- The Secretary is responsible to the President of the Chapter.
- Have a working knowledge of the National Constitution and Chapter Rules found on the Rolling Thunder® Indiana Chapter 1 website.

## **Chapter Board Member**

### **Duties and Responsibilities Description**

The Chapter Board Member is an elected official with a (2) year term. The Chapter Board Member enhances the organization's public standing by clearly articulating the Rolling Thunder® mission statement, accomplishments, and goals to the public and garners support from the community.

## **Chapter Alternate Board Member Duties and Responsibilities Description**



**The duties of the Alternate Board Member will include, but not limited to the following duties.**

- Reports to the Chairman of the Board.
- Must attend all scheduled Board meetings and special Board meetings as determined by the Chairman of the Board or Chapter President.
- Must not miss (3) consecutive meetings without legitimate excuse submitted to the Chairman of the Board or Chapter President.
- Makes recommendations to the Board that will help promote the Chapter's mission and goals.
- Participates in Board discussions as presented by the Chairman of the Board or other Board Members.
- Votes in the absents of a Board Member on subject matters as directed by the Chairman of the Board.

## Membership Patches



**The Chapter Boot Patch.** All members will receive a Rolling Thunder® Membership Boot patch when they become a full member at the end of a 120-day period. If a member meets his/her obligations before the 120 days are up they are entitled to receive their Boot patch no earlier than 90 days, provided they meet all other (loyalty and conduct) requirements. A new member must make 3 meetings or events, or a combination thereof, during the 120-day trial period to become a full member. **A \$50.00 patch deposit is required before National will issue the Boot Patch.**



**The Rocker and Eagle Patches.** After a member completes his/her first year (from the day they receive their boot patch) as a member in good standing, they will be issued the Eagle & Rocker patches, **which is the property of National.** **A \$100.00 patch deposit is required before National will issue the Rocker and Eagle Patches.**



**The Junior Membership patch.** The Junior Membership patch is available to individuals that wish to join the Chapter that are under the age of 18 years old. Once the Junior Member becomes 18 years old, they will be able to become a full Chapter member and eligible for the Chapter boot, Rocker and Eagle patches when they meet the requirements. The Junior Membership patch is no cost to the Junior Member.

In 2019, we have three POW\*MIA Chair of Honor displays that we are working on for three different venues. **The venues include:** The Plainfield High School Plainfield, Indiana, the Indiana Veterans Memorial Cemetery Madison Indiana, and the Grissom Air Force Base Museum Peru Indiana.

**Plainfield High School.** The Plainfield students are still working on the Chair of Honor platform. As soon as the students complete the platform, we will announce the dedication date.

**Indiana Veterans Memorial Cemetery.** The cemetery provided a chair that will be used for the Chair of Honor. The chair was taken to the upholstery shop to be reupholstered with the POW/MIA theme. Dick Harrington has completed building the platform that the POW\*MIA Chair of Honor will be mounted on and the plaque is on order. The dedication date will be announce when the plaque has been received.

**Grissom Air Force Base Museum.** The museum provided a seat from a C119 plane that will be used for the POW\*MIA Chair of Honor. This seat will be a little more challenging and will require more work. The Golden Knights, is scheduled to appear September 7-8 at the Grissom's Air and Space Expo.
